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





## OPTICON @ VISION EXPO EAST GENERAL SESSION - A CONVERSATION WITH REBECCA ALEXANDER, LCSW-R, MPH

Imagine your life without sight and sound. How would you live your life differently if you knew that soon you would no longer be able to see or hear? Rebecca Alexander has been simultaneously losing both her vision and hearing since she was an adolescent. Born with a rare genetic disorder called Usher syndrome (type 3), Rebecca was told that by age 30, she'd be completely blind. Then, at 19, one year after a fall from a second-story window left her body completely shattered, she discovered she would lose her hearing as well. Despite these obstacles, Rebecca refuses to lose her drive and zest for life and rises above and beyond every challenge she faces.

Join us on Friday afternoon as Blair Wong, ABOM, NCLEC catches up with Rebecca on her accomplishments, challenges and the encouragement and inspiration that Rebecca gives to others who are facing their own challenges.
